POSITION SUMMARY

The Waywayseecappo First nation (WFN) Health Centre is currently seeking a highly motivated individual for the fulltime position of Community Health Nurse. Under the direction of the Health Director, the Community Health Nurse will be responsible for providing a comprehensive range of core nursing functions and services (community / public health, primary care and home care) in the community. They will work independently and as a member of an interdisciplinary team. The Community Health Nurse will focus on promoting health, preventing disease and injury, protecting population health, as well as a focus on curative, rehabilitation, and supportive or palliative care.

KEY RESPONSIBILITIES

- Work collectively with the health team in delivering of Public Health Services.
- Plan, implement, deliver and evaluate community public health programs.
- Provide nursing services in a wide variety of settings (clinic, school, community).
- Knowledge, skills, competence and professional judgement as it relates to the concepts of health promotion, disease prevention, health education, group process and community development.
- Perform physical assessments of all age groups, undertake a wide variety of procedures/techniques (mandatory programs vision/hearing screening, immunization, STI management, etc.).

- Current registration and in good standing with the College of Registered Nurses of Manitoba
- RN or BN from recognized educational institution
- Experience in Public Health Nursing
- Knowledge of Federal/Provincial Health Care systems
- Knowledge of First Nations Community Health Programs, Immunization: HIV/AIDS Program, CPNP and ADI Programs
- Willingness to complete immunization certification
- Knowledge of First Nations cultural practices, traditions and customs
- Experience working within a First Nation organization and/or ability to speak Ojibway an asset
- Must have excellent oral and written communication skills
- Must possess sound clinical judgement
- Advocate for clients, patients, community members
- Proficiency in computer software applications
- Possession of valid MB Driver's Licence and access to a reliable vehicle
- Must provide a clear Criminal Record Check with Vulnerable Sector, Child Abuse Registry Check and Adult Abuse Registry Check
- Must be willing to submit a pre-employment drug test and future random drug testing
